



# Oh Susannah

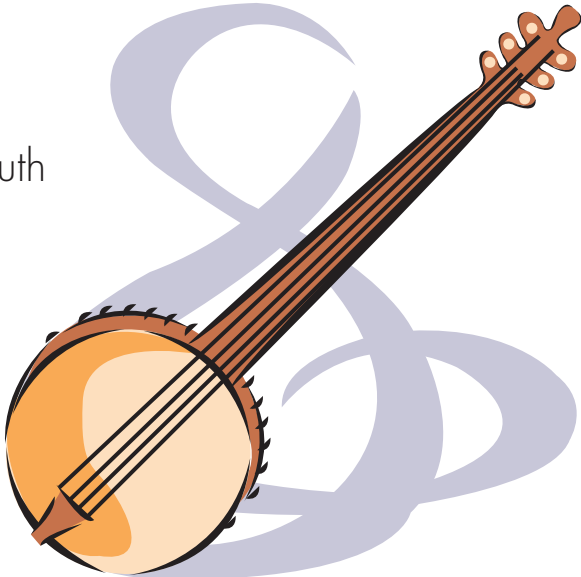
